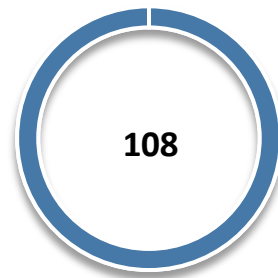

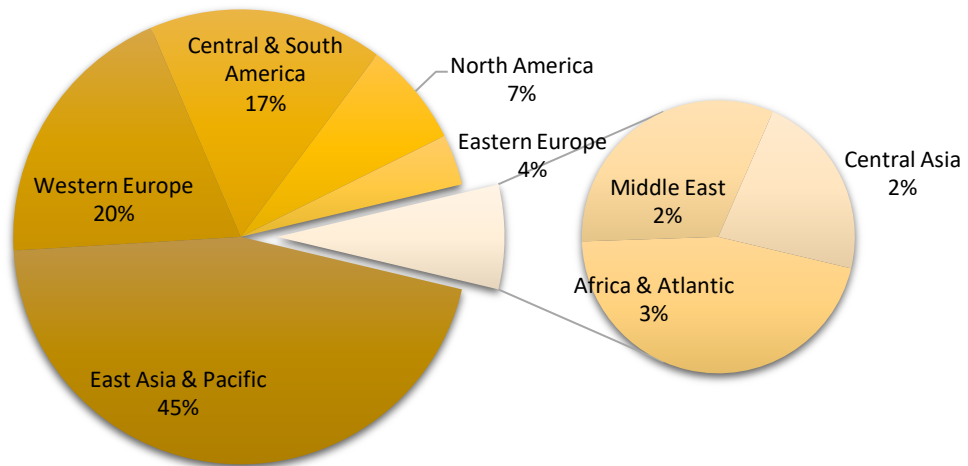

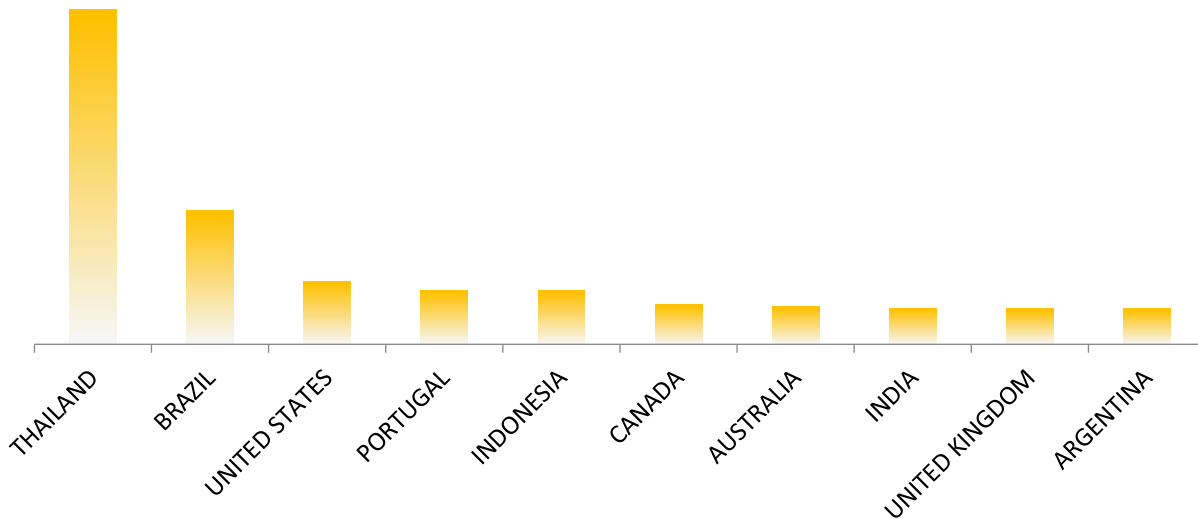
Countries Represented 2020



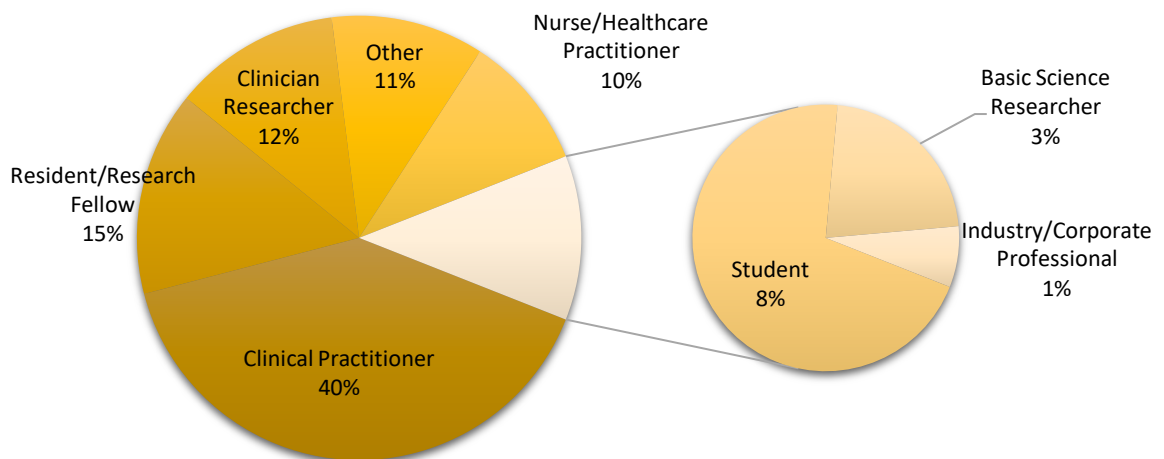

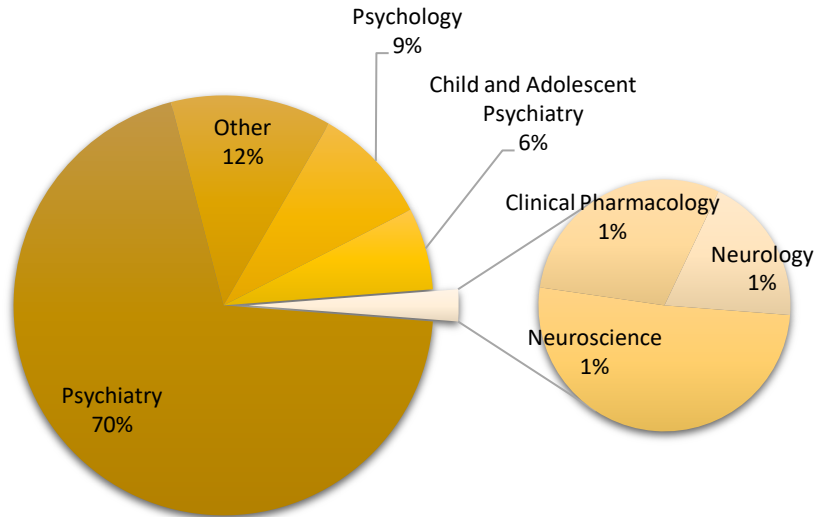
Top 10 Countries



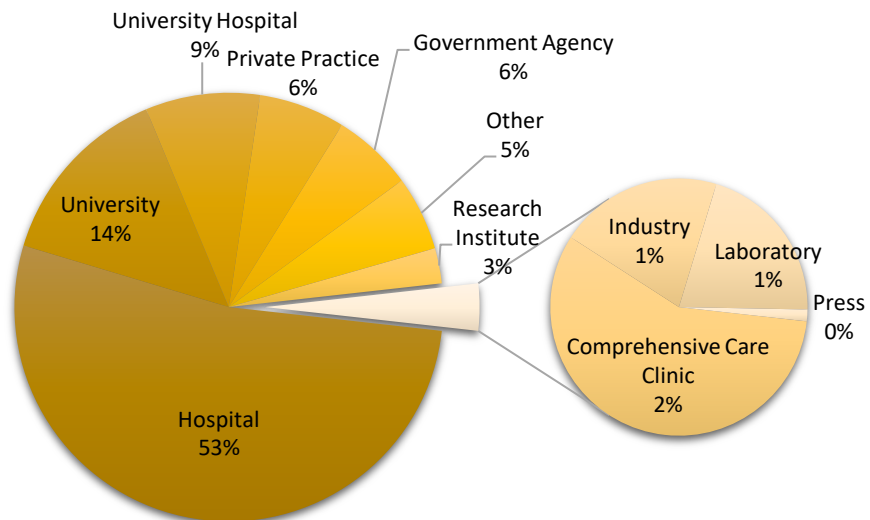

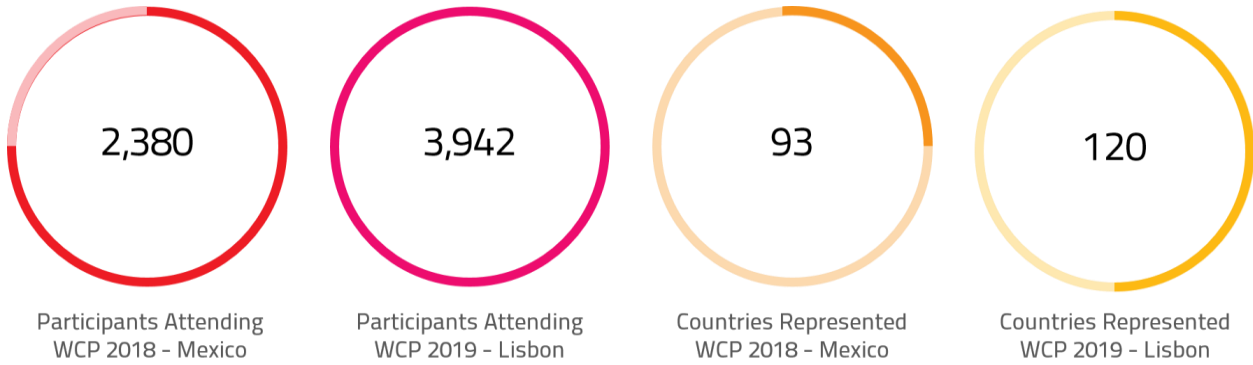

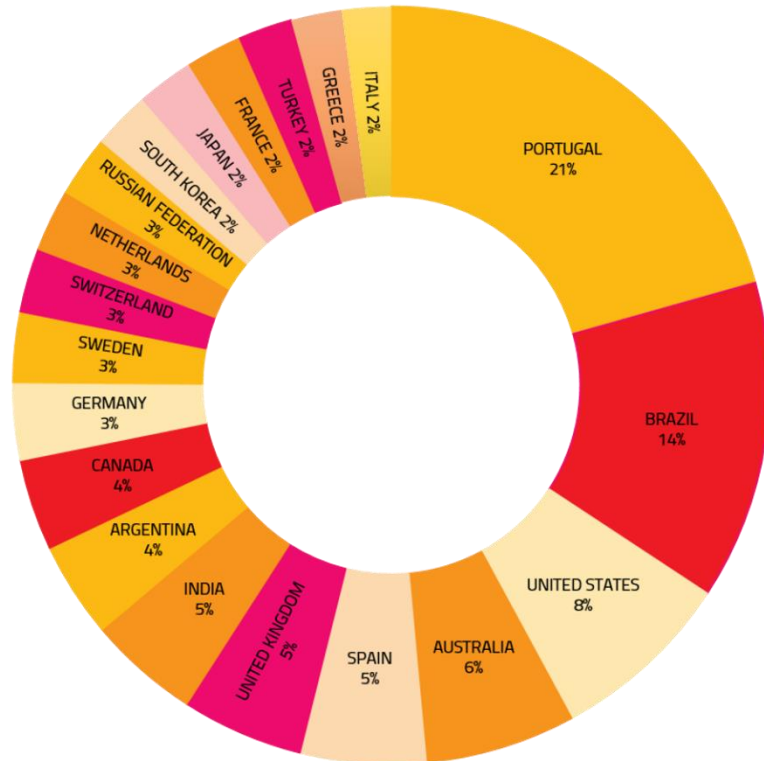


Demographics from World Congress of Psychiatry in Lisbon, August 2019, and Mexico City, September 2018.

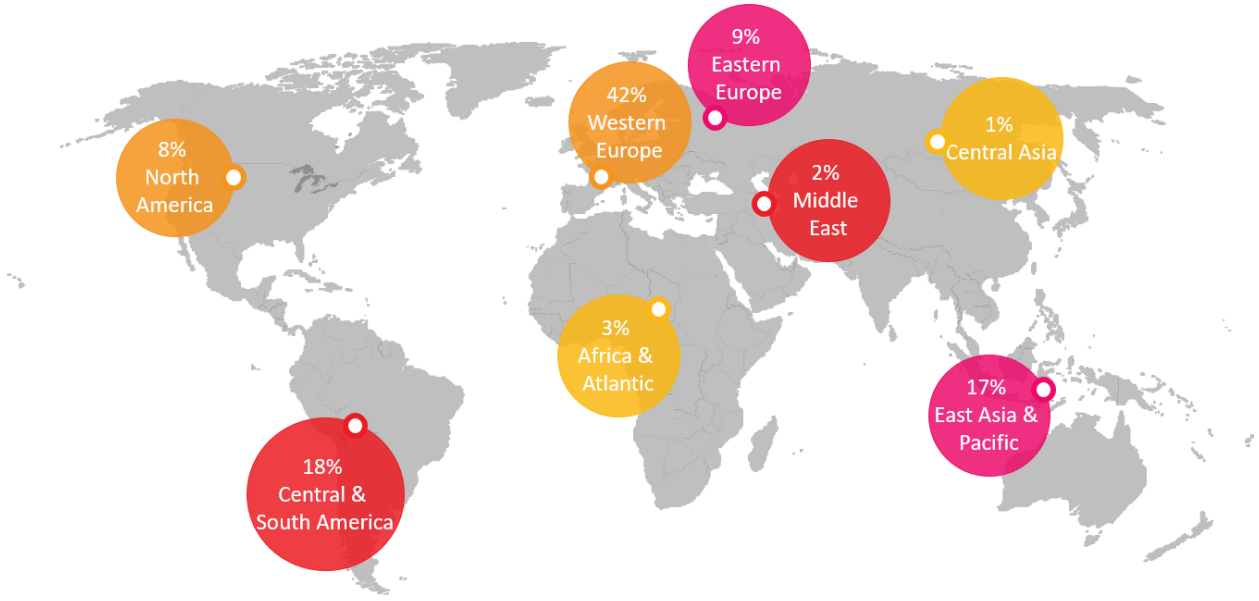

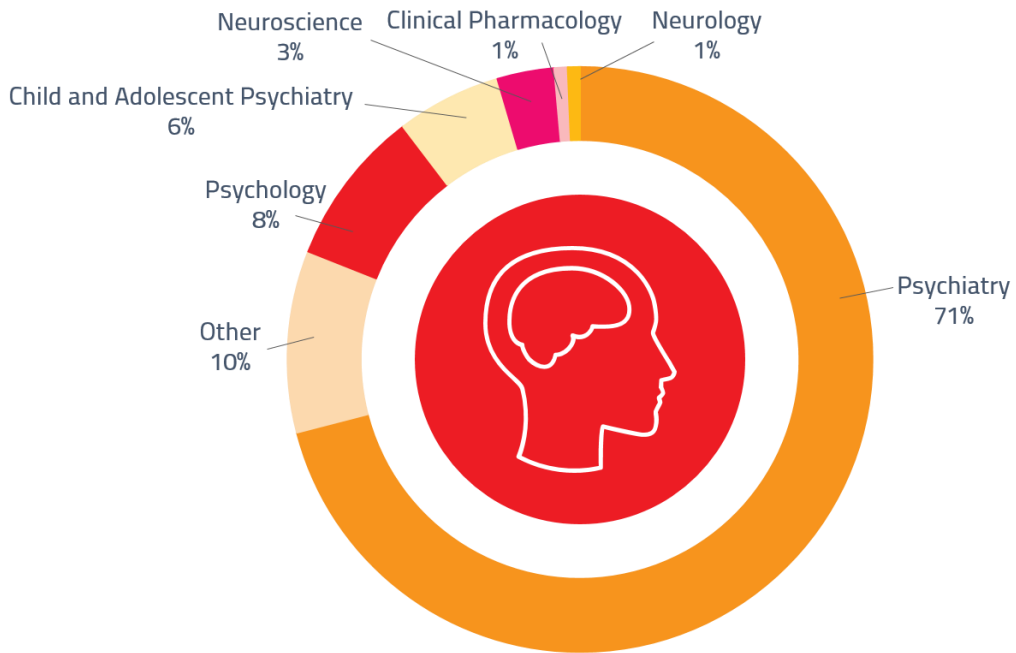
Top 20 Countries



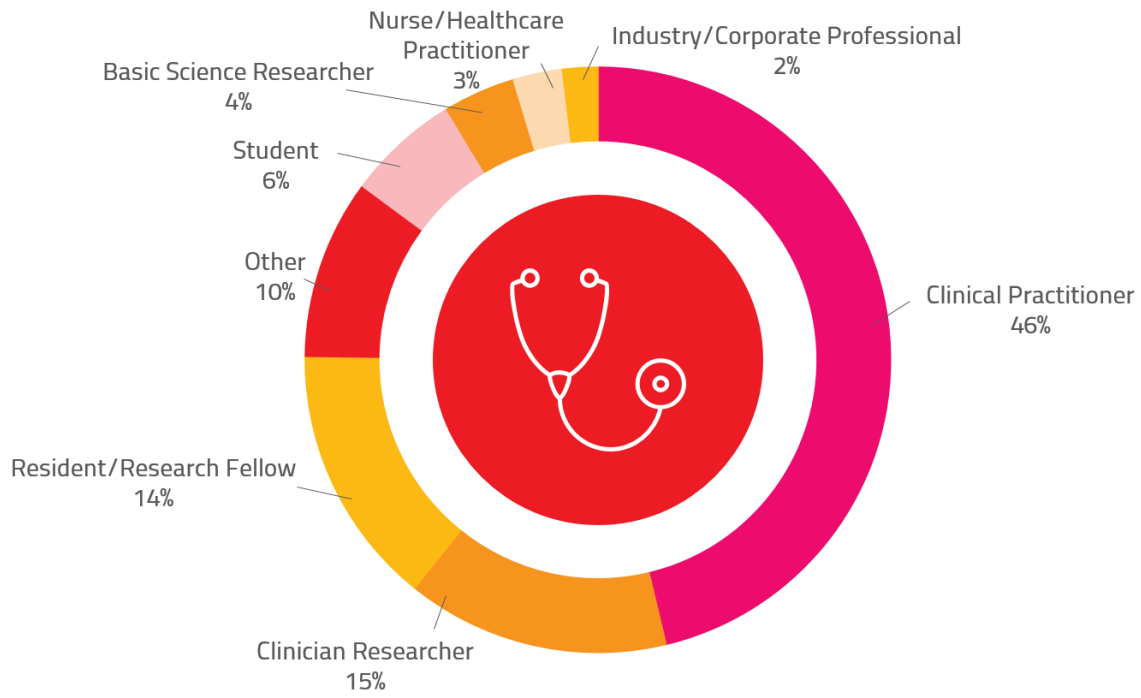
Participants by World Regions

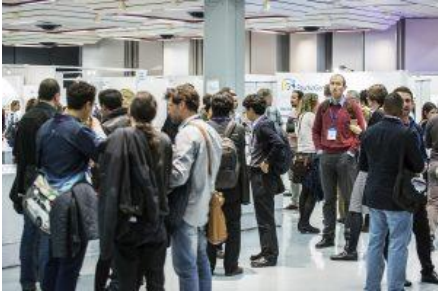

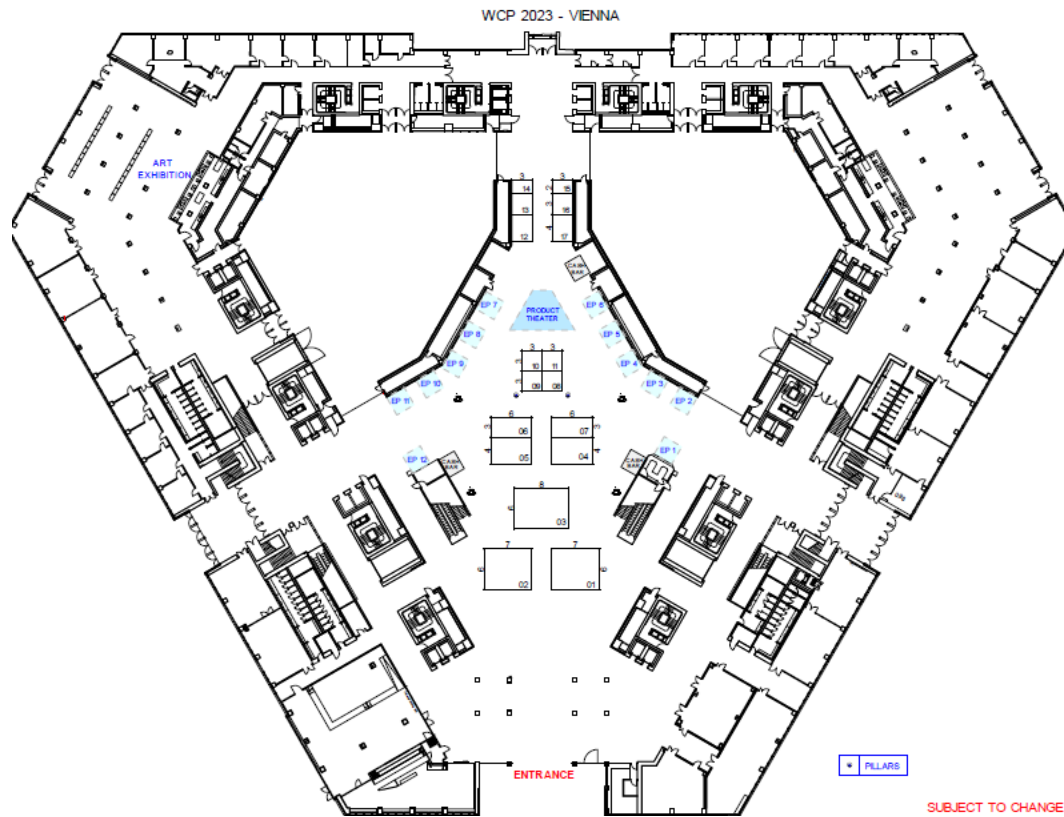

Exhibitors Badges Rules & regulations

ALLOCATION OF EXHIBITION SPACE

Space Allocation will be made on a “first come, first served” basis. A completed Exhibition Booking Form and Contract must be sent/ emailed to ensure reservation of a desired location. Upon receipt of the Exhibition Booking Form and Contract, space will be confirmed, and an invoice will be sent. Please note that three alternative booth choices should be clearly indicated on the application form. Space allocations will be made in the order in which application forms with payment are received.

EXHIBITOR REGISTRATION

All exhibitors are required to be registered and will receive a badge displaying the exhibiting company name. Two exhibitor badges will be given for the first 9 sqm booked and one additional for each 9 sqm after. Any additional exhibitors will be charged an exhibitor registration fee. Companies can purchase a maximum number of exhibitor registrations as follows:

- Booths of up to 60 sqm – 15 exhibitor registrations
- Booths larger than 60 sqm – 25 exhibitor registrations

Exhibitor registrations allow access to the exhibition area only and shall be used by company staff only. An exhibitor registration form will be included in the Exhibitor’s Manual.

EXHIBITORS' TECHNICAL MANUAL

An Exhibitors' Technical Manual outlining all technical aspects of exhibiting will be available approximately 3 months prior to the Congress. It will include the following:

This organizational decision has been made for the safety and efficiency benefits to exhibitors and for the successful flow of the Congress.

PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES
