WRITING SCIENTIFIC PAPERS FOR SUCCESSFUL PUBLICATION IN PEER-REVIEWED MEDICAL JOURNALS: An Interactive Workshop

This interactive workshop is designed to learn essential steps and augment skills that will enable attendees to successfully publish their scholarship in writing for peer-reviewed journals. Participants will discover rich information and techniques for:

- (i) Successfully navigating the manuscript publication process from selecting a journal to responding to reviewers;
- (ii) Becoming knowledgeable about the broad range of scholarly projects and article types that can be published, including original research, brief communications, reviews, and more;
- (iii) Producing effective scientific writing that meets readers' expectations;
- (iv) Applying techniques for maximizing productivity as writers;
- (v) Application of artificial-intelligence (AI) tools and becoming familiar with online resources that facilitate successful scientific publication; and
- (vi) Being attentive to ethical issues during publication.

This workshop is organized in three parts:

- a) 60-minute didactic introduction;
- b) 90-minute interactive process with participants, reviewing vignettes (or personal publishing experiences) that illustrate successful negotiation of challenges across the many steps in the publishing process; and
- c) 30-minute summation with 7 KEYS to SUCCESSFUL PUBLISHING IN PSYCHIATRY

Target audience: early-career and mid-career academic psychiatrists, psychiatrists in training (both residents and fellows), other mental health professionals with an interest in research and scientific publication; early academics
